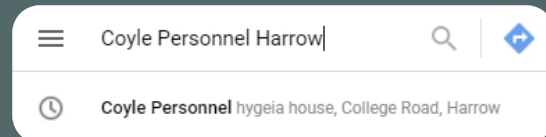
Step One

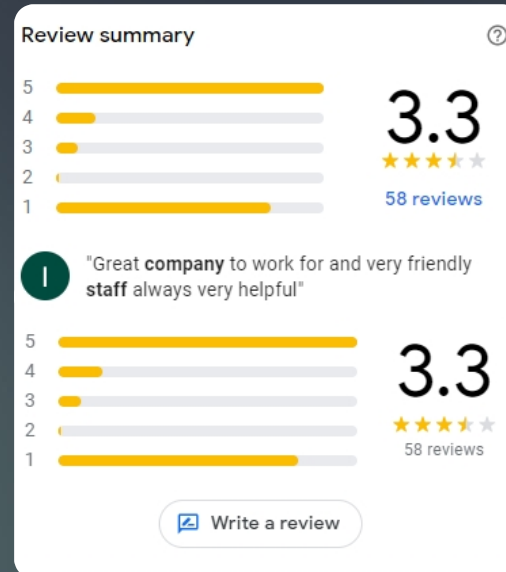
Step Two

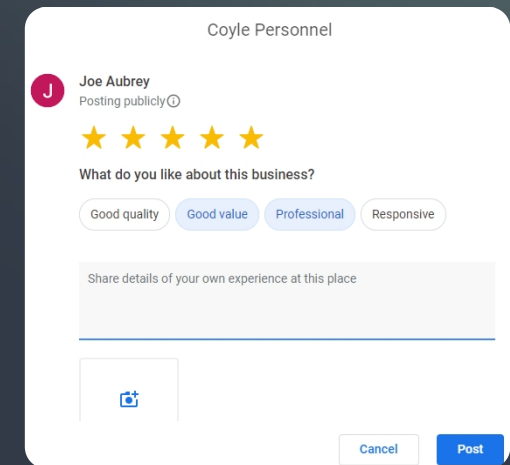

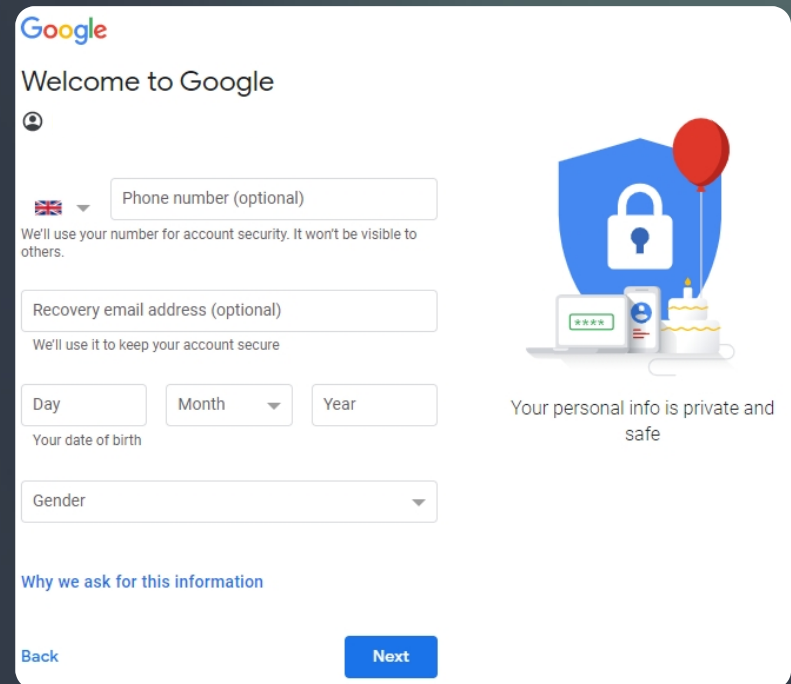
